The Tor group of 54 recorded claims was optioned in July 1963 by Triform Explorations (B.C.) Ltd. Geochemical soil sampling indicated a weak anomalous zone, which was explored by trenching. Work by the company ceased in November 1963 and the option was subsequently dropped.

The property was held as the Jim and Green groups (72 claims) by Summit Oils Limited during 1969-1970. Work included geochemical surveys, and magnetometer and electromagnetic surveys over 9.9 line-miles.
