DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The country rocks in the mineralized area are ribbon chert, argillaceous quartzite, argillite, slate and greenstones; they are ranging in age from late Pennsylvanian to early Permian.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT The J claim group is reported to be located near Henrietta Lake, approximately 2 miles south of Babine Lake and 7 miles southeast of Silver Island Landing. The J 1-48 claims were staked on known copper showings in

April 1966 by F.P. Thode, of Vancouver, for a prospecting syndicate comprised of W.P. Knox and A.J. Thiessen, of Vancouver. Knox and Thiessen incorporated Tapin Copper Mines Limited in October 1966 and the J claims were transferred to the company by an agreement of January 1967. By another agreement of January 1967 the company acquired the T 1-32 claims for G. Thomas, L.B. Pond & associates, insiders of the company. These claims, staked by F.P. Thode in October 1966, are reported to be located about 3 miles southeast of Silver Island Landing. Magnetometer surveys on both claim groups were carried out in 1967 over known copper showings. By 1972 all claims had been allowed to lapse except the J 1-4 and J 9-16.
