Endako Mines Ltd. in 1970-71 held the Ben 1-10 claims and, adjoining to the north, the Pat, Mist, and Dolly groups comprising 71 claims. Work on the Ben group in 1970 included 7 line-miles of magnetometer survey, a geochemical soil survey (200 samples), and about 2,000 feet of trenching on Ben 5 and 6. During 1971 a geochemical soil survey (263 samples) was carried out over parts of the Pat, Mist, and Dolly groups, and 2,066 feet of percussion drilling in 8 holes was done on the Pat group.
