DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A stockwork of quartz-molybdenite-pyrite-magnetite veins occurs in kaolinized and sericitized quartz monzonite.

Associated minerals or products of value

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 3,000 foot elevation east of MacDonald Lake, 4 miles south of the village of Endako.

Endako Mines Ltd. in 1970-71 held the Ben 1-10 claims and, adjoining to the north, the Pat, Mist, and Dolly groups comprising 71 claims. Work on the Ben group in 1970 included 7 line-miles of magnetometer survey, a geochemical soil survey (200 samples), and about 2,000 feet of trenching on Ben 5 and 6. During 1971 a geochemical soil survey (263 samples) was carried out over parts of the Pat, Mist, and Dolly groups, and 2,066 feet of percussion drilling in 8 holes was done on the Pat group.
