## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is largely underlain by folded and faulted Bowser Group (?) sedimentary rocks intruded by biotite-feldspar porphyry. Chalcopyrite and molybdenite occur in the intrusions and in the contact zone with the sedimentary rocks.

Associated minerals or products of value - Molybdenum.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,500 feet elevation south of Natlan Peak, 17 miles northeast of Hazelton.

The Nat 1-20 claims were held in 1971 by Noranda Exploration Company, Limited. Work included geological mapping, and a geochemical soil, silt, and rock sample survey.
