Disseminated chalcopyrite and pyrite occur in Takla Group volcanics close to their contact with the Hogem batholith.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 4,000 to 5,000 feet on "Roy" Creek, 22 miles west-northwest of Germansen Landing.

The Haggis 1-8 claims were held in 1971 by Falconbridge Nickel Mines Limited. A geochemical soil survey (187 samples) was carried out over all the claims.
