DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT  
 The area is underlain by Takla Group volcanic rocks cut by numerous intermediate dykes from the nearby Hogem batholith. Disseminated pyrite and chalcopyrite occur in altered volcanic rocks and in certain dykes.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 23 miles west-northwest of Germansen Landing.

The Bill, Big, JT, and Sid groups, totalling 139 claims, were acquired by Newco Ventures Limited, which was incorporated in September 1970. Pyramid Mining Co. Ltd. optioned the property in August 1971. Work under the agreement included geological mapping, soil geochemical and ground magnetometer surveys, bulldozer trenching, percussion and diamond drilling.
