## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is at the contact of Takla volcanics and quartz diorite intrusions. Mineralization includes copper sulphides and magnetite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Iron.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located south of the west end of Chuchi Lake.

The Tan, RT, and SK groups, totalling about 120 claims, were held by West Coast Mining & Exploration; no record of this incorporation has been found. Work during 1967 included geophysical and geochemical surveys. In 1969 electromagnetic and magnetometer surveys were made over 106 line-miles, and a soil geochemical survey (5,000 samples) was carried out.
