## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the south side of Tchentlo Lake, about 5 miles from its eastern end.

The ISA group was one of several claim groups, totalling 120 claims, held in 1969 by West Coast Mining & Exploration; there is no record of this company as a Canadian incorporation.

In 1970 and 1971 the ISA group was one of several held by Boronda Mining Corporation Ltd., of Los Angeles, under the name Black Hawk and Vectora (see also 93 N/2, Cu 4). Work during 1970 included geological, electromagnetic, induced polarization, and geochemical surveys.
