DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showing lies at the contact of a small granitic stock with andesite of the Upper Triassic and later Takla group. The showing consists of scheelite, powellite, molybdenite, and chalcopyrite disseminated through a fracture zone at least 12 feet wide in silicified andesite at the granitic contact. Two grab samples assayed: 0.075% WO₃; 0.015% MoS₂; a trace of gold; and 0.70 ounce of silver a ton.

The showing lies at about the 3,900 foot elevation on the south side of Jean Marie Creek, 9 miles south of the east end of Tchentlo Lake and some 54 miles southeast of Takla Landing.
