Minor copper and molybdenum occur along contacts of diorite and quartz monzonite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 4,700 and 5,700 feet elevation near the headwaters of Halobia Creek, 6 miles east of Tsayta Lake.

The Hal 1-28 claims were held by Noranda Exploration Company, Limited. Work during 1971-1972 included geo-chemical soil and silt surveys comprising 669 samples, an induced potential survey over 7.5 line-miles, and a magnetometer survey over 10 line-miles.
