Scheelite occurs in quartz stringers in axial plane cleavages in fold zones contemporaneous with movements of Manson fault zone.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 2,500 foot elevation near Manson Creek.

The Martin Mine, Limited, held the Billy, Glo, Golden Beauty, Golden Key, Blue Bird, and Blue Jay groups totalling 58 claims. The claims were under option in 1970 to Falconbridge Nickel Mines Limited. Work included geological mapping, trenching, and packsack drilling in 6 holes totalling 250 feet on Golden Key 1 and Golden Beauty 3 claims.
