Sphalerite occurs in brecciated carbonate rocks of Upper Devonian age.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located near the head of the Nabesche River.

Cominco Ltd. held the Nabe 1-141 claims during 1972-73. Geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey, and 133 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes was carried out in 1972. During 1973 a geochemical soil survey (118 samples) was carried out over Nabe 37-40 and 566 feet of diamond drilling in 3 holes was done on Nabe 35, 36, and 38.
