A small granitic stock intrudes Takla Group volcanic rocks. Disseminated chalcopyrite occurs locally in volcanic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,000 feet elevation on the south bank of Matetlo Creek, 3.5 miles from its mouth.

The Palace 1-6 claims were held in 1972 by Union Miniere Explorations and Mining Corporation. A geochemical soil and silt survey (121 samples) was carried out.
