DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT
Gently inclined basaltic lavas of the Takla group are traversed by a shear zone about 5 feet wide trending N50°W and dipping 75° northeast. The zone is exposed for a length of 50 feet and contains scattered knots of epidotized rock with a little bornite, malachite, and azurite. A picked sample of the mineralized materials assayed: gold, 0.01 ounce a ton; silver, 0.30 ounce a ton; and copper, 3.30 per cent. About 630 feet above this occurrence a vertical fault which strikes N55°W is about 20 feet wide and contains sheared and epidotized volcanic rock with a little hornite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showings are located 5 miles north of Asitka Peak at the head of the Ingenika River.

Texore Mines Limited staked 42 claims in the Arn and Jim groups in 1965. Additional staking was done in 1966 to a total of 126 claims, extending the property northward to surround the D.S. group and southward across Johanson Creek; adjoining ground to the south was staked by an associate company, Black Giant Mines Limited, as the Sil and Jim groups (see Cu 2).

Work by Texore during 1966 included geological mapping, trenching, and 993 feet of diamond drilling. Results were disappointing and the claims were allowed to lapse in 1968.
