A little native copper is reported from serpentine and red volcanic rock.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 2 miles southeast of Asitka Peak and about a mile east of Sustut Lake. Two copper showings, about a mile apart in an east-west direction, were noted by C.S. Lord on Map 962 A.

Prospector R.M. Godfrey, of Vancouver, prospected this vicinity in 1945 and noted an occurrence of native copper. The Arjay 1-20 claims were held in 1962 by W.D. Savage and G.L. Holbrooke; a geological survey was carried out at that time.
