OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT
 The Lawyers property is underlain by Jurassic and Younger Toodoggone volcanic rocks and Sustut Group sedimentary rocks. Near the northern part of the claim group, Toodoggone dacite porphyries and pyroclastic rocks are brecciated and silicified. Two random grab samples from this zone assayed 34.6 and 0.9 ounces per ton silver. The silicified zones are reported to contain very fine-grained native silver and electrum. No pyrite was noted in the area of the showings.

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
 The property is located at approximately 5,500 feet elevation between Saunders and Lawyers Creeks, 10 miles southwest of Toodoggone Lake.
 The Lawyers 1-54 claims were held by Kennco Explorations, (Western) Limited. During 1970 a geochemical soil survey comprising 900 samples was carried out over 10 claims. Regional geological mapping and soil, silt, and rock geochemical surveys were carried out in 1971 over the property and nearby Kodah and Saunders (94 E/6, PB 1) claim groups. In 1972 further geochemical survey work was carried out over the Lawyers group and a magnetometer survey on the Kodah group. During 1972 a geochemical survey of approximately 130 soil and 50 rock samples, and trenching was carried out on the Lawyers group. Work in 1974 included a geochemical survey (220 samples), and 2,004 feet of diamond drilling in 4 holes on Lawyers 181 and 183.
