HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Jock Creek, about 12 miles north of Thutade Lake.

The Pillar group, about 80 claims, was acquired by Kennco Explorations, (Western) Limited. Geological, geo-physical, and geochemical surveys were carried out by Quebec Cartier Mining Company in 1967. During 1969 Kennco carried out a geochemical rock-chip and soil survey.
