DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Scheelite was found in a specimen of sulphide ore obtained by A. Jenson. Country rock, according to Jenson, is mainly flat lying garnetiferous gneiss, with some limestone and dykes of granite. Veins of quartz and possibly calcite are numerous. Some of the gneissic bands contain pyrrhotite, pyrite, chalcopyrite, scheelite, and molybdenite.
