Two showings of chalcopyrite and bornite in Devonian dolomite; one with a true width of 20' which returned values of 1.82% Cu and 0.2 Ag and another, which assayed at 9.14% Cu and .29 Ag.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Located 5 miles southwest of Kluachesi Lake, 6 miles north of the Muskwa River, and adjoining the Blue group, held by McIntyre Porcupine Mines in 1971.

Slocan Ottawa Mines Ltd. acquired 104 claims, 46 of which were optioned from West Point Mines Ltd. Following geological mapping in 1971 the West Point option was given up. On the remaining JM group work during 1971 included geological mapping, and 600 feet of drifting and cross-cutting. The company name (Slocan Ottawa) was changed in 1972 to Slocan Development Corporation Limited.
