DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain by Bonanza volcanics of Lower Jurassic age.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located east of the Stranby River, on the south slopes of Knob Hill, seven miles north-northwest of Holberg at 500 to 1,500 feet elevation. The property comprised 71 claims, A 1 to 51, 54 to 63 and H 1 to 10, owned by M. Gibbeson.

During 1969 and 1970 Challenger Mines Ltd. conducted geochemical and geological surveys over A 1 to 15 and H 1 to 10 claims and magnetic surveys on all of the claims.
