HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence lies approximately one-half mile south of Swanson Bay, on the southwest side of a creek which flows northwest into Swanson Bay.

In 1918, ownership of these claims belonged to J.C. McNichols, of Swanson Bay, and associates. A small amount of rock trenching was done by the owners during that year.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The deposit, which is a small, irregular mineralized zone in micaceous schist, lies in a faulted zone which is parallel to the schistosity, strikes north 30 degrees west and dips 65-75 degrees northeast.

The mineralized zone consists of quartz stringers and silicified schist containing considerable pyrite and a little galena, zinc blende and chalcopyrite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Zinc, copper.
