DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showing consists of a fissured and partly silicified zone in argillites of the Nass formation near the contact with the Bear River greenstones. The zone is about 7 feet wide, has a northwesterly strike, and dips to the northeast at 70°. Along the footwall, as shown in a short tunnel, is a layer of quartz interbanded with argillites from one to two feet wide. The quartz is copper stained in places and contains some pyrite, galena, and sphalerite. Samples of the mineralized quartz are reported to have yielded high values in gold and silver. The Bear River greenstones near the contact are in places heavily impregnated with pyrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the north side and near the head of Del Norte (Porter) Creek, a tributary of Nelson Creek, about 20 miles east-northeast of Stewart.

The showings were originally staked and explored prior to 1913 by Messrs. Porter and Mowat; a short adit was driven at this time. The ground was restaked in about 1922 as the Delnorte claim Nos. 1-6 by Messrs. Green and Ficklin. Another group of 8 claims, the Delnorte Extension, was staked adjoining. There is no report of work done at this time.

The ground was restaked in 1938 by Owen McFadden and during 1939 the Nass River Mining Syndicate explored the showings by a series of open cuts and small pop-holes.
