DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The showings occur near the contact of a northwesterly trending belt of quartz porphyry and quartz diorite dykes. Two mineralized zones, one 6 to 12 feet in width, and the other up to 25 feet in width, are separated by a felsitic dyke. The zones strike N30°W, dip towards the granitic belt, and are irregularly mineralized with pyrite, chalcopyrite, and galena.

The Initial group is located at the 3,100 foot elevation on the west side of the Bear River opposite the mouth of La Sueur Creek some 10 miles north-northeast of Stewart. The claims lie south of and adjoining the Big Casino property. The Initial group was located prior to 1913. Very little work has been done on the showings.
