## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The showing consists of an area of zinc and minor copper mineralization over a strike length of approximately 2,000 feet and a width of 400 to 600 feet. The mineralization consists of sphalerite and chalcopyrite in an actinolite-magnetite-garnet skarn zone along a limestone-granodiorite contact.

Associated minerals or products of value - Copper, iron.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 3,000 feet elevation on the east side of Snippaker Creek 3 miles south of the Iskut River.

The Shan group of 20 recorded claims was held by Granduc Mines, Limited in 1963. The company carried out a geo-physical survey over 13 line-miles and geological mapping. Further geological mapping was done by Newmont Mining Corporation of Canada Limited in 1964.

The Shan 1-6 claims were staked by Skyline Explorations.

The showings were restaked in 1970 as the Shan 1-6 claims by Skyline Explorations Ltd. Geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey (224 samples), trenching, and bulk sampling were carried out during 1971-1972. The property in 1972 included the Snip 1-5, 9-15, 17, 18, 20, 22, 26-28 claims.
