DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by a series of green tuffs cut by quartz porphyry sills of the Premier type. The whole series strikes about north and dips 45° west. The showing at the creek occurs at a tuff-quartz porphyry contact and consists of stringers of pyrite and galena in a quartz gangue. The showing near the crosscut adit consists of a northerly striking silicified zone 8 to 10 feet wide in greenstone. Throughout the zone are small veins of pure quartz running in all directions. The whole zone is mineralized with pyrite and apparently carries some silver sulphides, mainly argentite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at the British Columbia-Alaska boundary about 1 mile southeast of Cascade Creek. Eight claims, the International, Cabin, Group, Lucky, Daly, Grub Stake, Grub, and Boundary (Lots 3922-3929) were held by Pat Daly and the Trites, Wood, & Wilson interests. Exploration and development work, done mainly in 1919, consists of open cuts, stripping, and a crosscut adit driven about 100 feet. The adit is several hundred feet short of reaching the vein. The claims were Crown-granted in 1922 to Messrs. Trites, Wood, and Wilson.
