Three northeasterly striking quartz veins on the property are mineralized with pyrite, galena and sphalerite. One of the veins is up to 15 feet wide.

This property is located on the south slope of Mount Dilsworth, east of and adjoining the Hercules property. The Forty Nine property adjoins to the north and the Unicorn adjoins to the south.

The property was staked in 1919 by Bill Murphy and associates and some surface work was done at this time. In 1923 the property was owned by H. McGuire & associates of Stewart. The Montana No. 1 Fraction and Montana No. 2 Fraction (Lots 4178-4179) were Crown-granted to Messrs. McDonald, Fenald, and Fraser in 1924.
