DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A quartz vein, reported to range from 1 to 16 m in width, carries minor pyrite and galena. Gold values range from 0.07 to 0.25 oz/t and silver from 0.7 to 0.18 oz/t. The vein has open pit potential.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located at elevations of 2 000 feet to 4 000 feet on the west side of South Unuk River, 2 km south of the mouth of Divelbliss (Cabin) Creek, some 48 km north-west of Stewart.

The showings were discovered and staked by Messrs. H.W. Ketchum, Lee Brant, Ceperley, MacKenzie, and Rounsfell, in 1901. A small stamp mill with a capacity of 3 tons per 24 hours was installed but there is no report of it having operated. Development work, carried out under the name Unuk River Syndicate, included stripping, 7 open cuts, and a 60 foot crosscut adit. An interest in the property was optioned to the British-American Development Company, Limited, of New Jersey. Six claims, the Globe, Dartmouth, Vancouver, Victoria, Cyclone and Blizzard (Lots 259-264 respectively) were Crown-granted to the owners in 1904.

Magna Ventures Ltd., operator of the adjacent Doc property (104 B/8, Au 4), in October 1986 optioned the Crown-grants. Sampling in the Globe adit and trenching was reported in 1987.
