Low values in gold, silver and copper were reported over a large area.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The claims are located at elevations of 4,000' to 6,000' across the lower end of Treaty Creek Glacier some 75 km north-northwest of Stewart.

Mineralization was discovered on Treaty Creek by two prospectors who in the fall of 1928 staked and surveyed 60 claims on behalf of The Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada, Limited. During July 1929 the company carried out preliminary prospecting but values were considered too low and the claims were abandoned. Although the location of this discovery is indefinite, it was apparently staked in part as the Twenty Mile 1-8, Ferro 1-11, Summit 1-6 and East 1-12 claims as shown on Map 104 B/9. A 1980 claim map shows the property staked as the Treaty claim (12 units) and King 1 and 2 claims.
