DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Sparse chalcopyrite in narrow quartz veins, and some malachite staining and sparse chalcopyrite in fractures in the adjacent volcanic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 3,000 foot elevation near Galore Creek, 50 miles south-southwest of Telegraph Creek.

The CW group of 167 claims, extending west from a position roughly 2 miles up Galore Creek from the Scud River, was staked early in 1964 by Conwest Exploration Company Limited. During 1965 induced potential and magnetometer surveys were carried out in an area on the east side of Galore Creek. By 1966 the property had been reduced to 69 claims; induced potential and geochemical soil and silt surveys were carried out during the year.

Amoco Canada Petroleum Company Ltd. optioned the CW group, now reduced to 16 claims, in 1970. Work during the year included geological mapping, and 3,006 feet of diamond drilling in 5 holes on CW 141 and 143.
