This property is located between elevations of 3,500 and 5,000 feet on the north side of the Anuk River, some 55 miles south-southwest of the Telegraph Creek.

The Devils Club group of 27 recorded claims was acquired by Anuk River Mines Ltd. Work on the claims during 1967 included geological mapping and 694 feet of packsack diamond drilling in 8 holes.
