HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located on the north side of the Porcupine River, 3 miles east of its junction with the Stikine River.

Honda Mining Co. Ltd. acquired the RM 1-10 claims in 1968. Work during 1968-69 included rock trenching and airborne magnetometer, electromagnetic, and nucleometer surveys. In 1970 diamond drilling was done in one 230 foot hole on RM 4.
