DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Mineralization occurs in float at a porphyry-Lower Cambrian limestone contact. The mineralization includes galena, sphalerite, pyrite, pyrrhotite, chalcocite, and magnetite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead, zinc, iron.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 3,700 foot elevation at the northeast end of Blue Sheep Lake, some 65 miles east of the north end of Dease Lake.

The Johnny 1-24 claims, owned by C.J. Shandella, were under option in 1971 to the Caltor Syndicate. The Syndicate was financed by Rayrock Mines Limited, Ashland Oil & Refining Company, and Canadian Industrial Gas & Oil Ltd. Work during the year included geological mapping, magnetometer and electromagnetic surveys.
