This property is located about 3 miles west of Gnat Lake and some 15 miles south of Dease Lake.

The showings were reportedly discovered by placer miners in 1898. A group of 10 claims was staked by Mike Williams in 1929 but no development work was reported at this time.

Newconex Canadian Exploration Limited acquired the May Group of 11 claims and during 1965 carried out a magnetometer survey on the property. Geochemical sampling was done over 550 acres in 1968.
