An appreciable width of quartz stringers and replacement with some pyrite mineralization is reported at the head of the canyon.

Bullion Creek flows southerly into the headwaters of Kutcho creek about 5 miles west of Rainbow Lakes.

Rodstrom Yellowknife Mines Limited, apparently staked 288 claims at Bullion Creek in about 1964. In 1965 the property was under option to Bullion Creek Mines Ltd., which was incorporated in December 1964 with Rodstrom holding a 50% interest. Work during 1965 included trenching, mapping, and prospecting.
