DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The claims are underlain by a succession of Cambrian and Ordovician metasedimentary rocks in a roof pendant surrounded on three sides by biotite quartz monzonite and granodiorite. On the Rye 81 and 90 claims a 3-foot northeasterly striking chloritized and silicified skarn zone containing scheelite outcrops for a length of 100 feet.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the north side of an easterly flowing tributary of Cassiar River, some 65 miles east of Dease Lake.

Conwest Exploration Company Limited held the Rye property (72 claims) in 1971. Geological mapping and a geochemical soil survey were carried out over the Rye 81, 83, 88, and 90 claims.
