The formation is identical with that of the Engineer mine adjoining to the north. Several northeasterly striking veins have been found but work has been confined to the Jersey Lilly vein. Only a slight amount of gold has been found.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on the east side of Taku Arm and lies south of and adjoining the Engineer group. The 6 claim Kirtland group was owned by Captain W. Hawthorn and Thos. Kirtland. The only work except prospecting was done on the Jersey Lilly claim in 1913 and consisted of 2 shallow shafts about 10 and 14 feet deep. Kirtland Gold Mines Ltd. held the property in 1925 but no work was done by the company.
