**A quartz vein in alaskite contains wolframite.**

A number of alteration zones occur within granitic rocks of the Cretaceous Surprise Lake batholith. Minor amounts of cassiterite occur in quartz veins in several alteration zones, locally with arsenopyrite, sphalerite, or chalcopyrite.
