DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The pay channel on Ruby Creek is cut in granitic bedrock, and is narrow compared with the channels of creeks with greenstone or ultramafic bedrock. The auriferous gravels are capped by a series of columnar-jointed olivine basalt flows, which in the shaft of Columbia Development Ltd., opposite the low pass to Cracker Creek, are more than 140' thick.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This creek was worked from 1906 until 1946. No activity has been recorded since that time.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION/HISTORIQUE DE LA PRODUCTION

From 1906 until 1945 a total production of 55,338 ounces of gold were recorded from Ruby Creek.
