HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between Ruby and Cracker Creeks, 3 miles north of Surprise Lake and about 16 miles northeast of Atlin.

Panther Mines Ltd. optioned the Hub 1-8 claims from Michael Nichiporick and Mrs. Len Pever, of Whitehorse, in June 1969. Work during 1970 included geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey, and trenching.
