Coarse rosettes of molybdenite occur in narrow quartz veins and on fracture planes in a 100 to 200-foot wide north-trending zone in weakly jointed hornblende diorite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,000 feet elevation at the head of Volcanic Creek, 15 miles northeast of Atlin.

Canyon City Explorations Ltd. held the Goodlife 1-8, 15-30, and Luck 1-48 claims. Work during 1970 included a geological and geochemical survey by Northern Empire Mines Limited, a geochemical survey by Canyon City Explorations, and geological mapping by Newmont Mining Corporation of Canada Limited.
