DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A quartz vein in alaskite of Cretaceous age strikes about N35°E and dips about 70° northwest. Vein widths range from 5 to 10 feet, with an indicated length of 900 feet. Of 25 channel samples the best gave: 0.3 oz. silver per ton, 0.67% WO₃, 0.02% copper, 0.05% lead, 0.02% molybdenum, and a trace of U₃O₈. The vein is possibly a continuation of No. 5 zone of the Wolframite property (104 N/11, W 2).

Associated minerals or products of value Silver, uranium.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 5,000 foot elevation on the west side of Ruby Creek, about 1.5 miles north of Ruby Mountain.
