DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

This occurrence consists of quartz veinlets in quartz-carbonate rock (carbonatized serpentine). Both the quartz veinlets and carbonate matrix carry small amounts of gold.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

Gold was discovered on this claim in 1899 by placer miners working in the bed of Pine Creek. The Nimrod Syndicate sank a shaft to a depth of 45 feet, but the work was stopped by legal complications. In 1902, a 100-foot trench was cut on the occurrence, and low values of free gold found. In 1903 the North Columbia Gold Mining Company deepened the shaft to 85 feet, and are said to have intersected the orebody at depth and to have found very high gold values in quartz filled fissures, reported to be of minable widths in the underground workings. The shaft is now filled with placer tailings.
