DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Silicified carbonate zones and fractured basic dykes with quartz stringers occur in a granite porphyry country rock. A sample across the 4 foot width of one of the veins, mineralized with a little disseminated pyrite, showed only a trace of gold and a trace of silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This occurrence is located at the 3,225 foot elevation on the northerly slope of Munro mountain, about 6 miles northeast of Atlin.

Four claims, the Cornerstone, Prince Eddie, Melbourne Cup, and Golden Link were owned by J. Reid, of Atlin in the 1920's and early 1930's. Exploration work consists of open cuts and a 40 foot long adit.
