DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The complete description of this property is not contained in any known reference. In the Annual Report of the B.C. Department of Mines for 1902, it is described as a ledge, which wherever tapped, is about 14 feet in width, mostly low grade, but containing many extremely rich patches.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This claim is situated in the bed of Pine Creek, but its precise location is not given in either report on the property.

Gold was discovered on the claim about 1900 through placer workings in the bed of Pine Creek. A shaft was sunk to a depth of 60 feet, with about 60 feet of drifting on the bottom level, and 30 feet on the 30-foot level. A general sample of 3½ tons shipped to Vancouver yielded \$49.97 in gold per ton (Gold at about \$20.00 an ounce).

No work has been done on the property since 1904. Great difficulties were experienced in the underground workings due to the heavy influx of water. This combined with difficulties over ownership, rather than scarcity or richness of ore, may have brought about the cessation of work on the property.
