McKee Creek has been worked by hydraulic methods more or less continuously since 1898. In the past few years work has been mainly confined to the north bank. In 1958, only one placer-mining operation, restricted by a lack of water, was being carried on - see A.R. 1958, p. 78.

The pay gravel at McKee Creek carries coarse gold well above the weathered bedrock surface, beneath deep glacial deposits.

From 1898, when placers on this creek were first worked, a total of 44,019 oz of gold have been recovered.
