HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located between elevations of 4,500 and 6,000 feet, about 2 miles southeast of the summit of Mount Haskin and some 13 miles east-northeast of Cassiar.

Bartle Explorations Ltd. acquired the Luna 1-6, 9 and 10 claims. Work on the property by J. Bartle during the period 1967-69 was limited to hand trenching. Brettland Mines Ltd. and Glen Copper Mines Limited optioned the property in 1970. Trenching was reported on Luna 2, 9, and 10 claims.
