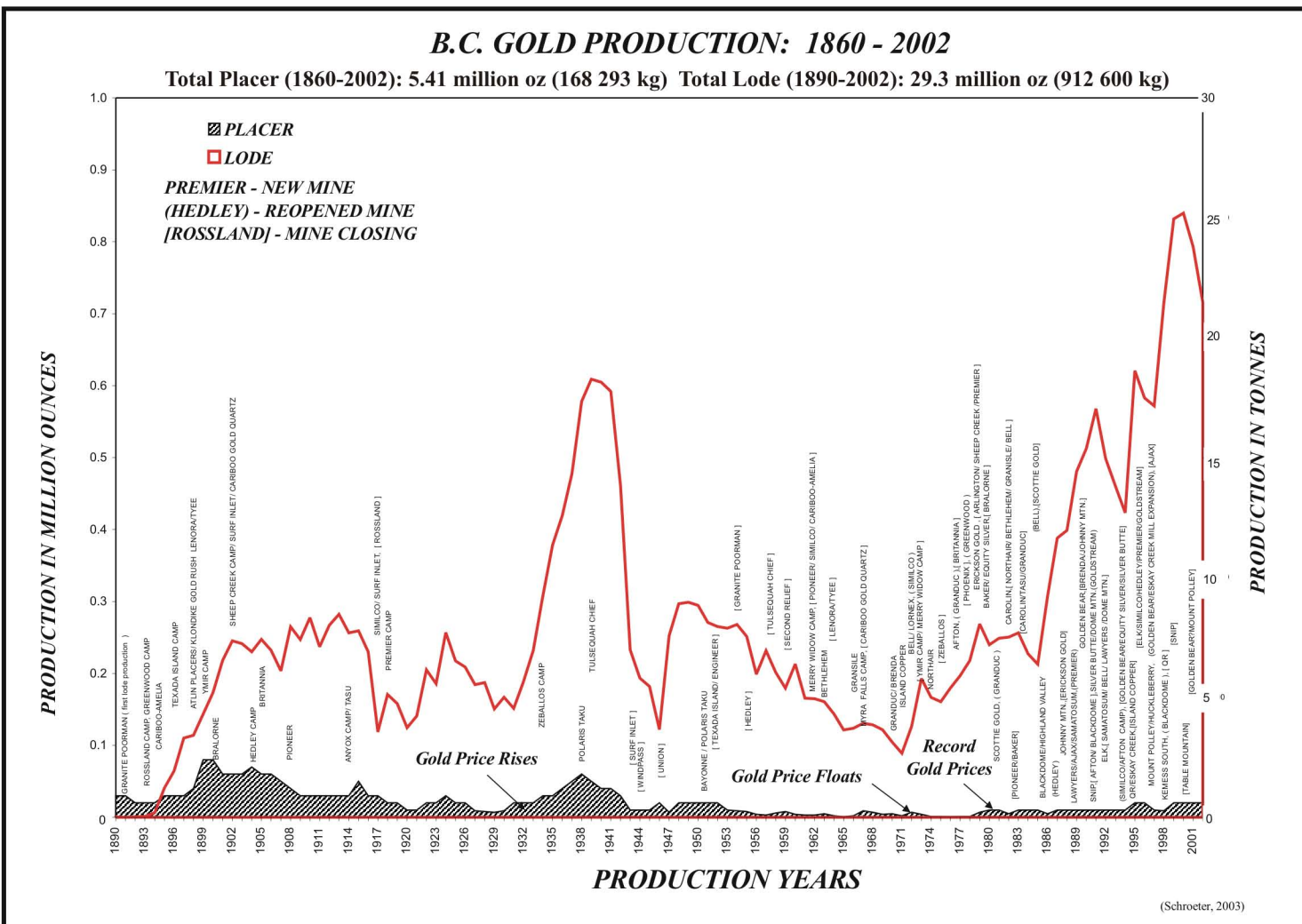
Notes:
